Transport Canada Hands on Workshop

Aircraft Owners are request to bring the following Documents to this Workshop;

- 1.) Pilot Licence and Medical Documents
- 2.) Aircraft Journey Log Book
- 3.) Aircraft Weight and Balance documents
- 4.) Certificate of Registration
- 5.) Certificate of Airworthiness or Special Certificate of Airworthiness
- 6.) If possible a digital photo of the aircraft Identification plate (ID plate)– If not able, then copy all of the information listed on the ID Plate on a piece of paper.
- 7.) Pilot Operating Handbook (POH) or Flight Manual
- 8.) Insurance Certificate
- 9.) Go to the following Website input your aircraft Registration marks, click on the double arrows to the right of the Reg. Box, and when the list of Airworthiness Directives is opened, print the list of Airworthiness Directive applicable to your aircraft. Please bring this list with you.
